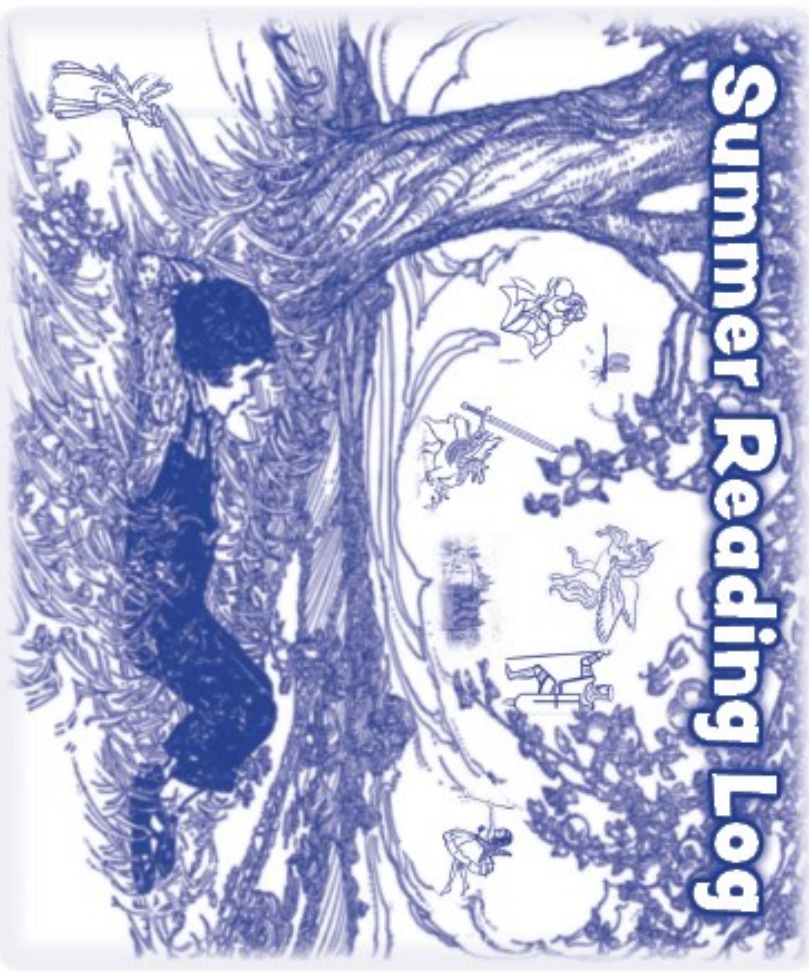

## Win Prizes! Have Fun! Read!

Track your progress by coloring or marking off one numbered book on the log each day you read, or complete an activity (see opposite).



To cross out or color a book you must complete:

- Pre-Reader (0-4 years): 15 min of reading
- Youth (5 years to 5th grade): 20 min of reading
- Teen (6th grade-12th grade): 30 min of reading
- Adult: 40 min of reading or one book read

You can always read more than the time given, but you can only cross out or color **ONE book** in a day!

## FAQs

### What happens when I reach the 15, 30, and 45 book spaces?

For Pre-Readers, Youth and Teens, we have collectible brag tags! Let us know when you have reached your 15, 30, or 45 day marks and/or 15 activities, and you will receive a prize! Adults participating from Silver Falls Library will earn Friends of the Library Book Sale Coupons for the 15, 30, and 45 day marks, as well as for every 5 activities. All participants will be entered into a prize drawing at the end of Summer Reading on Sept. 5, 2020, that supports our local businesses! You can fill out and submit the form below for the drawing.

Yes! Let the library know you need one and we will mail it to you or arrange for a pick-up at either Mt. Angel or Silver Falls Library.

### What if there is more than one person in my household who wants to participate in Summer Reading?

Our Town will have extra copies at select businesses and grocery stores, and you can also request one from your library. You can even print it from the Silver Falls website!

## Activities

To cross out or color a book for an activity, you must:

- Complete any activity listed and have fun!
- You may only cross out or color **ONE box** in a day!
- Pre-Readers, Youth and Teens who complete at least 15 activities will earn a special brag tag.



- Help someone make a snack.
- Draw a picture of a book you just read.
- Make up a fun song using your child's name.
- Read with a flashlight.
- Have a picnic inside or out with your favorite stuffed animals.
- Recite two favorite nursery rhymes.
- Read a board book and practice turning the pages.
- Clap along to the rhythm of a favorite song.
- Go on a shape scavenger hunt.
- Look at family photos together and name the people you see.
- Explore a book with flaps and/or textured pages.
- Go through the sidewalk obstacle course at Mt. Angel library.
- Make a fort inside or out.
- Create sidewalk chalk art.
- Write a handwritten letter to a friend or family member.
- Create a fairy garden with plants and items you have on hand.
- Read a fairy tale.
- Complete a backyard scavenger hunt from [silverfallslibrary.org](http://silverfallslibrary.org).
- Read a book based on a true story.
- Complete an online library craft from [silverfallslibrary.org](http://silverfallslibrary.org).
- Perform a puppet show or play from a book you read.
- Do a library Story Walk in Mt. Angel: new each month!
- Read a book and then watch the movie based on the book.
- Read a graphic novel that is either nonfiction or a biography.
- Read a book with a single word title.
- Write a poem or a short story.
- Do a virtual escape room [codc-qldc.govt.nz/blog/digital-escape-rooms](http://codc-qldc.govt.nz/blog/digital-escape-rooms).
- Read a book that is considered a "classic."
- Make a 1-minute rap to your favorite book.
- Choose a book by its cover and read it.
- Read a re-telling of a classic fairy tale.
- Listen to an audiobook! Library copies are available for checkout or online.
- Pick a craft to try in Creative Bug using your library card.
- Play a word game, such as Scrabble, Boggle, Word Search, Crossword Puzzle.
- Perform a random act of kindness (anonymously).
- Read aloud to someone for 20+min (pets count).
- Hike at least ½ of the Mt. Angel Heritage Trail.
- Download the Libby app and read an E-magazine.
- Watch a movie found on Kanopy.
- Write a book review.
- Read a book by an author who is new to you.
- Re-read a book that you enjoyed when you were younger.
- Complete the 2020 Census.
- Read at least one chapter of a book outside.
- Visit at least three different Silverton murals.
- Make a meal following a new recipe.
- Go to [Explore.org](http://Explore.org) and visit animals or a park virtually.
